Northern Corridor Transit and Transport Coordination Authority Statistician, Transport Observatory Project

The Northern Corridor Transit and Transport Coordination Authority (NCTTCA) is regional intergovernmental organization with the mandate to facilitate trade and transport along the Northern Corridor. The Northern Corridor is the transport system linking the Kenya sea port of Mombasa with the hinterland countries of Uganda, DRC, Rwanda, Burundi and South Sudan.

The NCTTCA is looking for qualified candidates to fill the post of Statistician for its Transport observatory Project. The transport Observatory is web based tool that monitors the performance of the trade and transport flows along the Northern Corridor.

The specifications for the job are as follows:

1. Duties and Responsibilities:

- a) Compile and analyze the data, and generate performance indicators on volumes, costs and rates, time and delays, efficiency and productivity and seasonal variations, traffic classifications, compliance to axle load limits, ports and border post clearance, vehicle operating costs, road user costs and accident statistics;
- b) Prepare weekly and monthly performance reports to stakeholders on the transport systems along the Northern Corridor;
- c) Ensuring analysis are complete and up to date through continuous flow of data from data providers and stakeholders;
- d) Liaise with stakeholders to address data gaps and to validate the observations arising out of the data analysis;
- e) Work with technical experts in preparation of monitoring reports for the implementation of the Mombasa Port Community Charter and other periodic statistical reports;
- f) Perform other related duties as required.

2. Qualification and Experience:

- a) Bachelor's degree in Statistics or Economics from a recognized university. Having qualifications in transport economics is an added advantage.
- b) At least three years experience in compiling and analyzing international trade and transport data.
- c) Demonstrate ability to independently provide significant program support.

3. Key Skills and Competencies:

- a) Advanced information technology skills with ability to work with SQL, Microsoft Office (word, excel, access), SPSS or any other statistical packages;
- b) Good interpersonal, intercultural and organizational skills;
- c) Good writing and communication skills;
- d) Good knowledge of English and/or French and ability to work in the other language; is an added advantage.
- e) Knowledge of ASYCUDA, SIMBA and KWATOS is an added advantage.

4. Duty Station: Mombasa, Kenya.

5. Contract Type: Service Contract (One year renewable based on performance)

6. Reporting: The Statistician for the Transport Observatory Project reports to the Head of Program, Transport Policy and Planning, NCTTCA Secretariat.
